BRUSSELS HOSTED THE FIFTH EDITION OF THE EUROPEAN UNION CYBER COMMANDERS MEETING, CYBERCO.

SPAIN ASSUMED COMMAND OF NATO'S STANDING MARITIME **GROUP 1**

Spanish Rear Admiral Joaquín Ruiz Escagedo took over the command of the SNMG-1 from German Rear Admiral Thorsten Max in a ceremony that took place in the NATO Hall of the German maritime base in Wilhelmshaven.

During the next six months, Rear Admiral Ruiz Escagedo will command NATO's standing Maritime Group number 1 (TG 441.01) aboard the frigate F-102 'Almirante Juan de Borbón'.

NATO INTERCEPTED RUSSIAN MILITARY AIRCRAFT OVER 300 **TIMES IN 2023**

In 2023, NATO air forces across Europe scrambled well over 300 times to intercept Russian military aircraft approaching Alliance airspace, with most intercepts occurring over the Baltic Sea.

Spain contributes several combat aircraft when it is called upon to activate them. In addition to the air assets, the Spanish Air Force deploys some 150 military personnel that make possible all the maintenance, logistics, surveillance and control tasks of the mission.

SPAIN BEGAN DEPLOYMENT OF GROUND FORCES THAT WILL FORM THE **BATTLE GROUP OF THE NATO MISSION IN SLOVAKIA**

The Spanish Armed Forces started on January 20th the progressive deployment of personnel and capabilities in Slovakia. Spain will lead a Multinational Brigade, maintaining permanently deployed a multinational Battlegroup in the town of Lešť which, in June, will relieve the one currently deployed led by the Czech Republic.

The task of this initial contingent is to establish the necessary conditions for the transition of mission leadership between the Czech Republic and Spain.
