## The Spanish contingent deployed in Mali takes over at the Koulikoro Training Centre

The Spanish contingent deployed in Mali took over on December the 5<sup>th</sup>. Brigade 'Extremadura XI' leads the 17th rotation of Spanish troops serving under EUTM Mali. Spain is the largest contributor of forces (24%).

Spanish troops are mostly deployed in the town of Koulikoro, northeast of Bamako, capital of Mali.

#### <u>Spanish frigate 'Reina Sofía'</u> <u>commemorates Operation Atalanta 12</u> anniversary

Operation Atalanta has its multinational headquarters in Rota, (Spain). More than 8,000 Spanish troops have served in this operation since it was launched, 12 years ago, probing Spain's commitment to the European Union and the maritime security.

Spanish frigate 'Reina Sofía' is currently deployed in the area, to counter piracy off the coast of Somalia.

## Air Detachment 'Orion' reaches 13,000 flight hours within Operation Atalanta
